by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Heilary N. Woodward
a certain tract or parcel of land being in the State and County above men-
tioned lying on the East side of Little Black Creek containing Two Hundred
and fifty acres more or less being part a tract of Land that I now live on and
part of tract of Land of the Estate of Heardy Sellers beginning at a post oak
corner on the Road leading to the cross roads Church following said Road
to the Spring head near the ford of the Uiny Branch thence a direct line to the
corner between myself and Aaron Gibson from thence running Aaron Gibson
line to the Uiny Branch thence a cross said Branch and following Aaron
Gibson's line to a corner on the Spring head of the Kecican Branch thence
up the Spring Branch to the mouth of the first slash below the head thence
on the N.E. side of said slash to a Stake corner thence a direct line to a
pine corner near Jesse Allen's fence from thence to Stake corner between
Abram Woodward and William Watson thence a marked line to the
